The Awards Committee will consider the following criteria:

- Meet requirements for grade 12 graduation this year.
- Will be pursuing post-secondary education at a recognized institution (college, university).
- Demonstrate a commitment to community service, social work, or initiatives that exhibit kindness, compassion, and a desire to contribute to the well-being of others.

Your application package will be graded based on a point system. Please include the following information with your application:

1. This form, filled out completely and placed as a covering page for your application.
2. An autobiographical essay that clearly identifies how you meet academic requirements to facilitate success in your chosen career path. Include descriptions of volunteer involvement, both at school and within your community. Ensure you highlight personal achievements, financial need, and state any other circumstances or reasons that you believe you should receive an award. Please let us know how you have been preparing to fund your education.
3. A description of short- and long-term goals, career-related or otherwise.
4. A letter of reference from a teacher at the educational facility from which you are graduating. Additional letters of reference are also welcome.
5. Your high school transcript showing grades achieved to date.
6. A copy of your Letter of Acceptance from the university or college where you are enrolled. If you don't have your Letter of Acceptance, you can submit a Confirmation of Application.
